PROGRAMS OFFERED

LL.M. (Hons.) [2-Year Course]

The LL.M. is a postgraduate degree in law, typically lasting two years. It offers in-depth knowledge and specialization in various fields of law through intensive research and coursework.

LL.B. (Hons.) [3-Year Course]

Legum Baccalaureus or LLB is a three- year Bachelor of Laws degree that is offered to aspirants by many renowned colleges in India. However, candidates can pursue this law course only if they possess a graduate degree. The three-year LLB course offered at most of the law colleges of India are regulated and closely supervised by the Bar Council of India (BCI).

B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) [5-Year Course]

BA LLB (Bachelor of Arts - Bachelor of Legislative Law) is a five-year integrated LLB course that candidates are eligible to pursue after completing Class 12. The Law course is an amalgamation of Humanities and Law streams, which allows candidates to study subjects such as History, Sociology, Administrative Law, Criminology. Family Law and so on.

B.B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) [5-Year Course]

Bachelor of Business Administration & Bachelor of Legislative Law (BA LLB) is a five- year course on completion of which the aspirants are offered a professional degree. BBA LLB is an integrated law course wherein aspirants are taught subjects related to Business Administration as well as Law. As part of a Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) LLB course aspirants are first taught Commerce subjects such as Principles of Management, Financial Accounting, Computer Applications, Effective Communication, etc.




